- b) In October/November 2018 students from Aschaffenburg will visit GESS. In October 2019 the return visit will take place. In 2020 GESS will be hosting again etc.
- c) The partner hosting the group of students from the other country, creates a detailed schedule and shares this with the other school at least three months before the visit.
- d) Both partners agree to provide a safe and appropriate environment for the guest students.
- e) The family of the exchange student will usually accommodate the guest student. Only in case of special circumstances another family might take over the accommodation, but this has to be arranged by the responsible family. The school will support and has to be kept informed at any time.
- f) Both schools appoint one teacher, who is responsible for the exchange program and who will supervise the students during their stay.
- g) The cost of the return flight to the guest country will be covered by the respective school sending the students. All other expenses will be paid for by host families. If visiting students take part in class trips of more than one day, they are to pay the same amount as their German counterpart.
- h) The exchange takes place for interested students of grades 10 and 11 who are open for communication and generally suitable for the exchange.

It is important for both partners to evaluate the activities during the exchange program and of the school partnership to determine the status-quo of the partnership program. This is to develop future measures and activities, based on a trustworthy mutual agreement.
